


#### 2 Chronicles 7v11-16

<sup>11</sup> When Solomon had finished the temple of the LORD and the royal palace, and had succeeded in carrying out all he had in mind to do in the temple of the LORD and in his own palace, <sup>12</sup> the LORD appeared to him at night and said:

#### Hebrews 12v1 Let us run the race that is before us and never give up.

The word *race* is from the Greek *agon*, from which we get the word agony. The Christian's race is not a jog but rather a demanding and gruelling, sometimes agonizing race. It takes a massive effort to finish strong.
