WHERE IS YOUR HEART

OT Hebrew for Heart is "Lev/Leb" The Inner Person; Emotions; Mind; Will; Bowels

OT Hebrew "Lebab" synonym (similar meaning) Both used interchangeably in OT 860 times

The "Heart" an important subject in OT writings

"Create in me a clean Heart O God"

Not "Yatzar" means to "Fashion" or "Form"

But "Bara" to "Create"

Gen1:1 "In the beginning God created....." NT Greek for Heart is "Kardia" Originally used to describe the "Pump" Lev17:11 ".. the life of the flesh is in the blood"

Later came to stand for Man's: "Mental" & "Moral" activities, both

Rational "How we try to understand" &

Emotional "What we feel"

"Kardia"

Figuratively

Thoughts (Mind) and/or Feelings

"Kardia" lies within the "Centre" of man's being & Refers to the "Inner life"

OT & NT

Coming together re purified Heart

OT. Opposite of Defilement is a quality called: "tohora/tohor" denotes: "Ritual purification" and the "consecration" of things set apart for God by means of "Atoning blood" Lev 17:11

"Lev tohor" David's appeal "Clean/pure Heart"

NT. Precious blood of the "Atoning" sacrifice of Jesus on the cross for our sins.

God's wrath against our sin/defilement is satisfied and He is able to create within us; "Lev tohor" – cleansed from the old nature's defilement and perversity.
